



HOME V Meeting: provisional programme

Main aims of the meeting:

- To achieve consensus on the definition of the “long term control” domain
- To achieve consensus on how to measure long term control
- To progress the domain of quality of life in children

DAY 1: Monday 12th June 2017, 13:00-17:30

13:00 - 13:30: Introduction session

- Welcome, background, update, and plans for the HOME V

13:30 – 17:30: Long-term control domain – agree definition

- Introduction and aims of the long-term control session
- Presentations of studies to inform discussions including:
 - Strategies used for measuring long-term control in atopic dermatitis trials; a systematic review
 - Clinician, researcher & patient perspective on long-term control; results of international survey and focus groups
- Whole and small group discussions: Is long term control a separate domain (e.g. flares) or a function of the repeated measures of the other domains (signs, symptoms and/or quality of life)?
- Provisional vote on the definition of long term control

DAY 2: Tuesday 13th June 2017, 09:00-18:00

09:00 – 16:00: Long-term Control domain – how to measure

Content and order is dependent on the results of the provisional vote from day 1 on the definition of long-term control.

- Whole and small group discussions, presentations of validation and other relevant studies, voting on key issues.
- Repeated measures: which instruments, methods of analysis, frequency of measurement.
- Definitions of flares, well-controlled weeks etc. and methods of measurement.
- Revisit provisional vote on the definition of long term control from day 1.
- Vote on *how* to measure long-term control in trials

- Update on progress of the symptoms working group since HOME IV
